



Getting Back on the Water

As lockdown measures in England are eased, we can't wait to start welcoming you back onboard for Half-hour City Cruises on **Saturday 4th July**.

Our priority is always to keep our crew and passengers safe. Here are some of the ways we will be doing this when we re-open:

Social Distancing

- Boats will operate at a reduced capacity with some seating removed to enable social distancing
- Tickets will be purchased on the quayside instead of on the boat — please use contactless payment wherever possible
- You can also book online ahead of your visit, and there's no need to print your tickets
- If it is necessary to queue on the quayside, please follow social distancing guidance
- Crew will let you know where to sit and when to disembark

Hygiene

- Crew will be frequently sanitising touch surfaces such as handrails and seats
- Crew and skippers will have masks and gloves for them to use if needed
- Hand sanitiser will be available for passengers and crew
- The bar and ticket kiosk will have hygiene screens
- Toilets won't be available on the boat so we can concentrate on cleaning other areas — public toilets are just a minute's walk away from our landing stage

Services

- We will be operating Half-hour City Cruises between 11am and 5pm
- We usually sail every 30 minutes — due to the reduced capacity of each boat, we might sail every 20 minutes on busy days
